From the East:



LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING, AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 SHOW PASS FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1)LEADLINE; 2)EXHIBITIONS; 3)GAMES AND RACES; 4)CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7)NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

Exhibitors are requested to thoroughly acquaint themselves with the following rules and regulations. Exhibitors participating in divisions recognized by the USEF will also be governed by this prize list. Any changes in the current USEF rule book will automatically become a part of this prize list. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All exhibitors are required to be thoroughly acquainted with any and all federal and state laws and regulations governing horses and horse shows. The American Royal Association, Inc., reserves the right to decline any exhibitor and/or said exhibitor's horses before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horses without being held liable for damages of any kind, and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry. In this event, all fees paid and prize money won shall be forfeited. It is also a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the American Royal Association, Inc, its directors and employees, and the UPHA, its directors and employees, harmless for any loss, damage or accident to horses or equipment.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes: 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions, 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in the Competition, and by signing the entry black, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or related in any way to be Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE, OR NEGLECT OR OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorney's fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) may participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect by (a) me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches drivers, contractors or invitees or invitees or (b) any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages, or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

Rules and Regulations

Entries close on September 4. All entries must be post marked by this date. Entries will be accepted after this date with a one-time late charge of \$30.00 per horse. Horses entered in the show may enter additional classes without a post entry penalty.

Deadline for entering classes are as follows:

8:00 pm for next morning classes.

One hour prior to session start for all afternoon and evening classes.

Arrival Time- Wednesday, September 16th not before noon.

Departure time- Sunday, September 20th by 8am.

Entries must be made under full registered name and a copy of registration papers, copy of the USEF and AHA membership cards for the owner, trainer, driver, and rider/handler must accompany the entry. Horses must be able to show proper registration.

The American Royal Arabian Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Arabian Horse Division. The premium list is based on the rules of the current Rule Book. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to USEF rules. Questions not covered by the USEF rules shall be decided by the show committee and its decision will be final.

Accounting or Bookkeeping: The owner of a horse is responsible for the liability to the show. NSF checks are presented twice. If the check is still NSF after the second presentation, it is automatically turned over for collection. This is an automatic banking system procedure. The American Royal reserves the right to charge a \$50.00 NSF fee.

AHA Membership Requirements: Owner, trainer, riders, drivers and handlers must be current members of AHA at the time of entry and showing. If one of the owners, trainers, riders, drivers or handlers is not members, they are subject to an AHA non-member fee of \$35.00.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

The American Royal Association, Inc. reserves the right to decline any exhibitor and/or said exhibitor's horses before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horses without being held liable for damages of any kind. This shall be accepted as a condition of entry. In this event, all fees paid and prize money won shall be forfeited. It is also a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the American Royal Association, Inc., its directors and employees harmless for any loss, damage or accident to horses or equipment.

Courtesy: Any discourteous act on the part of an owner, exhibitor, groom, trainer, or agent made toward judges, officials or other exhibitors will disqualify the entry and they will forfeit all fees and premiums. The Horse Show Committee shall have full power to act in issuing a ruling in such cases. Should the act justify it, the Horse Show Committee shall have power to exclude offender(s) from competition and remove them from the show grounds without being held liable for damages of any kind and this shall be accepted as a condition of the entry.

Dogs: Dogs are not allowed in the Hale Arena or in Grand Hall. Dogs in stable area are required to be on a leash.

Entries: Entries must be made on an American Royal Horse Arabian Show Entry Form signed by the owner, exhibitor, rider, driver, handler and trainer.

Feed and Bedding:

Due to rising costs regarding disposal of stall bedding materials, exhibitors are asked to purchase shavings and straw on site. Bulk deliveries of shavings will not be allowed. Thank you for your understanding. Feed, grain, hay, straw and shavings are available through the Feed Room. Orders must be placed between 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Feed and Bedding will be billed through the horse show office. Electrical Adaptors may be picked up in the show office. During the show, the Feed Room phone number is: 816.513.4107.

BEDDING:

Shavings: \$9/bag---Straw: TBD

Fees: All fees must be paid in full and accompany an entry form. No post-dated checks will be accepted. During the show, an open check may be left in the office for additional fees incurred during the show.

Footing: Hale Arena (Show Arena) is 110' x 205' and will be available after show hours for exercise with limited lighting in the evening hours. The Tom Bass Arena, (Warm-up Arena) is 140' x 300' will also be available. All arena and schooling arenas are a combination of screened sand and dirt.

Liberty Class: Liberty is limited to 6 entries. This will be accepted on a first come basis. Horses will be shown with halters on. Horses will have 2 minutes to perform and 2 minutes to be caught. Music may be provided, and must be submitted to the show office prior to the show. Open to Half Arabians and Purebred Arabians.

NEW ARABIAN SCORING SYSTEM FOR HALTER CLASSES

The Arabian Scoring System and New Ring Procedures for Arabian Breeding/Gelding In-Hand Classes (Purebred and Half-Arabian/ Anglo-Arabian) WILL BE IN USE at these competitions. For this show, the "In the Ring" Class Procedure will be used. (See USEF Rule Book, AR 107 for details). The approved score sheets will be used for all Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes, with an individual score sheets will be used for each horse- the Master Score Sheet will be posted at the show office. Show will designate a halter paddock bagging person.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES:

7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Ownership Requirements: The ownership of all horses entered in the show must be clearly stated on the entry form. Copies of registration must be included with submission of entry.

Premium Payment: Premiums will be paid by check no later than 30 days after the show. Horses placing 1st, 2nd or 3rd in qualifying classes must show back in the respective championship class or forfeit their winnings.

Refund: Request for refunds must be received in horse show office with a veterinarian certificate to receive refund. Office fee is non refundable. Vet outs are subject to a 40.00 vet out fee.

RIDING AREAS: All arenas/school areas are a combination of sifted sand/dirt.

ARENA DIMENSIONS:

Hale Arena –120' X 220' Tom Bass Arena – 125' x 225'

Stalls: Box stalls are portable vinyl (9 ½' x 9 ½') with doors. Stalls will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis with exception to Premium Stalls. No bedding is furnished with stalls. No reservations for stalls can be made without full payment. **Premium stalls are a one–time \$150 charge to ensure an aisle location. Damage to stalls will be at owner's expense!**

Supreme Halter Championship Classes: The Supreme Halter class is only for Champion and Reserve Champion horses and any first place horses that are not eligible to show back in a Junior or Grand Champion class. These classes will be judged utilizing a comparative judging system, rather than the point system. There are no entry fees for these classes.
