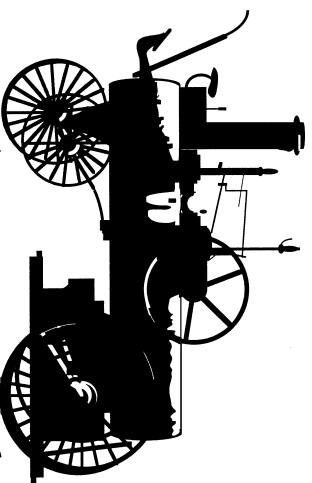

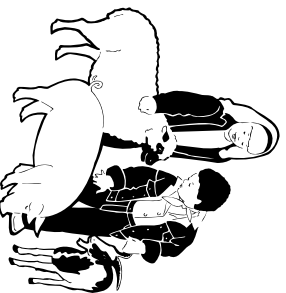

There are few other opportunities during the year that you can...talk to the youth and their families about their experience in raising, grooming, and showing their animal; encourage other youths through your involvement; see old friends; build lasting friendships; visit with friends and other buyers during the Buyer's Pre-Auction Brunch; promote your business by appearing on the new buyer's list; and participate in one of the longest-standing, highest respected and attended community activities.

... ON SALE DAY

UPON YOUR ARRIVAL, SIGN UP FOR YOUR BUYER'S NUMBER. FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE, SALE CATALOGS WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE listing all animals in order of sale, their weights and owner's name. **BE SURE TO PICK UP A BUYER'S NUMBER AT THE SALE DESK.**

As each animal enters the ring, the auctioneer will ask for bids in CENTS PER POUND. When the animal of your choice enters the ring, simply raise your buyer's number. Or, if you want, you can make arrangements for someone else to buy an animal for you. If you need help bidding, ask one of the ringmen for assistance. The bidding will continue until the highest bid is reached. The highest bidder gets the animal. Whether or not you buy, your bidding will help the sale.

After buying, a runner will present you with a sale invoice. At that time, you must indicate the disposition of the animal. **Your choices are:**

A. CUSTOM KILL AND RETURN. The animal will be processed, inspected and delivered to one of the butcher shops in the area. A slaughter charge will be included in your bill.

You will need to indicate your preference from the list of choices and make arrangements with them for cutting instructions. A cut and wrap charge will be assessed when you pick up your meat.

B. RESALE. Animals that are bought by individuals who do not desire the meat, (have bought the animal to support the auction), will be resold at market price, at a later date, and you will be billed for the difference between the market price and your bid.

This is a terminal sale. All large animals sold at this auction will be transported to the USDA approved processing facility contracted with by the Amador County Fair. Transportation will be provided by the Amador County Fair. The split carcass (with the exception of the resale animals) will be returned to the processing plant of the purchaser's choice. Animals consigned for sale and sold through the auction are not eligible for repurchase.

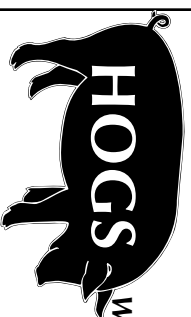

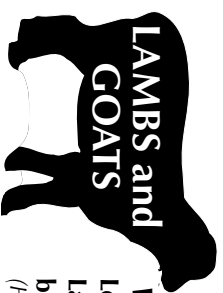

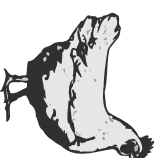
