ARTS & CRAFTS DIVISION RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will reflect respect of themselves, their organizations and their parents .Any exhibitor who violates these rules of conduct may forfeit all privileges and premiums, and in some cases, may be barred from future competition in this show as the Rules Committee or the executive Committee may order.
2. EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY -To compete in the Angelina County Youth Fair Arts &Crafts Division, an exhibitor must be enrolled in a public or private school in Angelina County of less than college level on the day of the show. Exhibitors must be enrolled in an art class (and have an art teacher to coordinate through) or be a member of 4-H, FFA or FCS.
3. Exhibitors will be divided into four age divisions:
 - a) Pee Wee -grades K-2 the Pee Wee age group is eligible for ribbon awards. This age group is not eligible for auction cash awards.
 - b) Pre-Junior -grades 3-6
 - c) Junior -grades 7-9
 - d) Senior -grades 10-12
2. TIME OF ENTRY & CHECK IN - The online entry verification form and fee of \$10.00(excluding Pee wee entries) are due on the 3rd Friday in January to the organization representatives. Representatives must have all forms & money to the Chamber by the following work day. Actual items will be checked in at the Angelina County Exposition Center on Wednesday, February 25, 2015 from 2- 7 p.m. **(East side by Special Events Room)** All entries and ribbons must remain on exhibit until time of check out. Items must be removed between 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. on Saturday after the show and not before.
3. Each exhibitor will be permitted only one entry per division, with a maximum of five entries for the show. Questions arising in classification of entries will be resolved by the superintendent in charge of the Arts & Crafts Division. No entry will be accepted in "miscellaneous" if it can appropriately be entered in another more specific area. There will be no substitutions and exhibitors may not switch divisions once the entry form has been turned in.
4. All classifications will be checked the day of the show by a superintendent. **All entries must be within 40 square foot in size.**
5. All entries must not have been previously shown in the Youth Fair. All entries must have been made by the exhibitor since Youth Fair last year. All art work shall be suitable for display to the general public. Exhibitors should avoid adult themes or subjects in the displays, and may be disallowed in the discretion of the superintendent or Youth Fair Committee.
6. Metal, Woodworking, Wood/ Metal Combo and Others Division will be required to have documentation of construction of the project entered. A Standardized photo book consisting of 6-12 pictures with descriptions of construction of crafts & woodworking projects is to be turned in at time of check-in.
7. Exhibit areas will be closed during judging. Judges decisions will be final.
8. SALE OF ITEMS WILL BE:

9. You must notify the arts & crafts show officials at check in if you plan to sell your projects. There will be a 5% commission charge on all sale items. No exhibitor may sell more than one item. Exhibitors are requested to be present at auction to sell their item, or have an alternate represent them.
10. No framed photography or art work will be accepted. All drawings, paintings and watercolor projects must be mounted.
11. Security services are provided for exhibitors in the Angelina County Youth Fair and every precaution will be taken to protect all articles entered; but in no case will the Angelina County Youth Fair nor the Angelina County Chamber of Commerce be responsible for loss or damage.
12. AWARDS: Blue, Red and White Youth Fair Ribbons will be awarded to all entries on the basis of quality rather than first, second or third ranking. For example, more than one blue award would be given in a particular class. In addition, the following place ribbons will be awarded in all age categories in all divisions: Fine Arts, Other, Woodworking, Wood/Metal Combo and Photography. Best of Show, First, Second & Third. Best of Show winners (those selected for auction) will be indicated by the posting of winners, not just by rosettes.

Home accessories, Decorative Hand or Machine Work

Photography Division: No framed photography accepted.

Photography - Black & White or Color (8 X 10 mounted on 11X14)
Photography - Picture Story (3 to 6 photos mounted on 11 X 14 should depict a sequence or communicate a message.)

Woodworking Division:

Home Accessories, toys or recreational items

Wood/Metal Combo Division

Home Accessories, toys or recreational items

Metal Division

Home Accessories, toys, recreation items or miscellaneous items constructed out of primarily metal. All construction and/or welding must be completed by the exhibitor. Wood fasteners and/or fastened accessories may exclude the item from the metal category.
