Embrace the rich history of the Texas Independence Trail Region, 28 southeast Texas counties stretching from San Antonio to east of Houston in Liberty and Chambers counties, the upper Texas coast from Galveston to Port O'Connor and north to Bastrop and Brenham.

Celebrating Texas' struggle for independence from dictator Santa Anna in 1836, the main sites tie the theme and showcase many other attractions.






