- 1. The Terms and Conditions will form part of the contract between the County and the successful bidder. Failure to comply with all of the Terms and Conditions may subject the offer to rejection.
- 2. All bids shall be sealed, addressed and **delivered before 3:00 p.m. (local time) on FEBRUARY 5, 2015** to: The Finance Department, Courthouse, 100 North Main, Suite 11, Lovington, New Mexico, 88260. Please mark the outside of the envelope "BID #06 (14-15)". It is the bidder's responsibility to see that the bid arrives on time. Late bids, faxes, telegrams or telephone bids will not be accepted. Bids will be opened and read aloud at 3:00 p.m. on FEBRUARY 5, 2015 on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the Lea County Courthouse.
- 3. Each bidder is to submit its bid on the form provided. The form must be fully completed.
- 4. All bids must be mailed or delivered to Lea County, Finance Department, 100 North Main, Suite 11, Lovington, New Mexico 88260.
- 5. The bid shall exclude all State taxes on material costs. Nontaxable transaction certificates will be issued if requested. State taxes for services including installation costs should be included.
- 6. All bidders will be notified by letter of the Board's award.
- 7. Bid specifications indicate the minimum standard of quality, performance or other pertinent characteristics required. Terms which equal or exceed these specifications will be considered. All options, variations or exceptions to specifications must be listed.
- 8. In case of ambiguity in stating bid prices, the County reserves the right to adopt the most advantageous interpretation.
- 9. The County reserves the right to waive technical irregularities in the form of the offer which do not alter price, quality or quantity, and to reject any or all offers when it is in the best interest of the County to do so.
- 11. In signing this bid, the Contractor certifies that there has been no direct or indirect action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with this bid submitted to Lea County.
- 12. The Lea County Procurement Policy and the New Mexico Procurement Code, NMSA 1978, Sections 13-1-28 through 199, as amended, shall apply to this procurement and prevail over any inconsistent terms and govern all interpretations of contract documentation. In addition, criminal laws prohibit bribes, gratuities and kickbacks.

  - a) General liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 aggregate.
  - b) Automobile insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00.
  - c) Workers Compensation insurance as required by New Mexico State Statute.
  - d) All insurance shall remain in full force and effect for the entire term of the contract or until work is completed.
  - e) Awarded firm will ensure that sub-contractors (if any) carry the same insurance coverages as listed above.

#### **GENERAL:**

Lea County is seeking bids for a contractor to purchase, demolish, and remove the salvage of an existing metal aircraft hangar, misc. interior rooms and concrete foundations. (hereinafter referred to as "Hanger #E1"). Bidder may elect to use the resulting materials of demolished building as future building materials, salvage, or repurpose at alternate location. Hangar #E1 is located at the Lea County Regional Airport in Hobbs, New Mexico.

### **DESCRIPTION:**

#### Location

The subject aircraft hangar is located at the Lea County Regional Airport in Hobbs, New Mexico. The subject is located approximately 2.0 miles west of Hobbs on the Carlsbad Highway (U.S. Highway 62/180). Maps and pictures are attached.

### **Site Size and Dimensions**

Hangar #E-1 is located on airport land, which is owned by Lea County. The building size has been determined to contain 10,839± square feet plus an 1,196± square foot attached covered shed.

### **Description of Work**

Successful bidder will be responsible for the removal and disposal of all building components including all building sheeting, structural steel, wire, insulation, office flooring, office walls, ceiling, and any material above natural ground level including any concrete. The asphalt paving under building can remain. Location is to be left totally cleared, with no debris remaining.

### **Security Requirement during work**

Contractor shall install 6' tall temporary chain link fencing on the south side of hangar building throughout the duration of project.

#### **Duration of Project**

Contractor shall be given 30 days from the Notice to Proceed to complete work. Liquidated damages of \$200 per calendar day will be assessed after that time.

#### **Existing Environmental Sensitive Material**

Any necessary environmental remediation to the building will occur prior to Notice to Proceed. Environmental work will be completed by separate contract.

<u>Required Site Visit</u> -- Contractors are required to site inspect the building prior to submitting a bid. Contact Lea County Regional Airport at (575) 391-2942 to schedule an appointment.

**CONTRACT:** Contractor will be expected to enter into a contract with Lea County as attached.

### Campaign Contribution Form (Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 81, Laws of 2006, any prospective contractor seeking to enter into a contract with any state agency or local public body must file this form with that state agency or local public body. - "Campaign Contribution" means a gift, subscription, loan, advance or deposit of money or other thing of value, including the estimated value of an in-kind contribution, that is made to or received by an applicable public official or any person authorized to raise, collect or expend contributions on that official's behalf for the purpose of electing the official to either statewide or local office. "Campaign Contribution" includes the payment of a debt incurred in an election campaign, but does not include the value of services provided without compensation or unreimbursed travel or other personal expenses of individuals who volunteer a portion or all of their time on behalf of a candidate or political committee, nor does it include the administrative or solicitation expenses of a political committee that are paid by an organization that sponsors the committee.
- "Contract" means any agreement for the procurement of items of tangible personal property, services, professional services, or construction.
- "Family member" means spouse, father, mother, child, father-in-law, mother-in-law, daughter-in-law or son-in-law.
- "Pendency of the procurement process" means the time period commencing with the public notice of the request for proposals and ending with the award of the contract or the cancellation of the request for proposals.
- "**Person**" means any corporation, partnership, individual, joint venture, association or any other private legal entity.
- "Prospective contractor" means a person who is subject to the competitive sealed proposal process set forth in the Procurement Code or is not required to submit a competitive sealed proposal because that person qualifies for a sole source or a small purchase contract.
