General Information

The Arizona National is located in the state of Arizona. Our 67th Annual Livestock Show will be held on the Arizona State Fairgrounds *December 27, 2015 – January 1, 2016*. Our Annual Horse Show is set for January 2-7, 2016 at West World in Scottsdale, AZ

<u>Exhibitor Participation</u>: This is a National Show open to the World with more than 3,000 exhibitors participating from 25 states and Canada representing Beef Cattle, Swine, Sheep, Meat Goats, Horse, Poultry and special event activities. The states having the "greatest" number of participants are from AZ, CA, TX, NM, OK, CO and KS although the Midwest is well represented as a group.

Ranch Replacement Heifer Show & Sale

The Arizona National Ranch Replacement Heifer Show & Sale set for Sunday, December 29, 2015 at the 68th Arizona National Livestock Show in Phoenix, AZ.

This event, chaired by Clay Parsons and Rick Lehman of The Marana Stockyards, Marana, AZ will provide an opportunity for Arizona Cattle Ranchers to showcase the best replacement females representing their genetic program and its superior offering of heifers that are Arizona raised and Rock Footed. These cattle will work in tough southwest environments and produce calves each year that fit real world agriculture. All cattle will be subjected to a

rigorous pre-show sift to guarantee a standard of perfection and soundness required by any cattle buyer. Details regarding the show and sale will be available soon online. Rick can be contacted at 602-481-3879.

Four Divisions will be offered for pen of three (3) ranch raised, commercial replacement quality Heifers. Heifers may be either purebred or crossbred. Cash premiums and awards are offered. Entry is open to Arizona raised cattle from Arizona owned ranches. Four Divisions offered:

- **Division I: European and British Breeds;** Pen of (3) three Bred Heifers (purebreds and/or crossbreds); Females 15-36 months of age on or before December 31, 2015. Consignors must provide pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner, licensed veterinarian at time females are processed at the show.
- **Division II: European and British Breeds;** Pen of (3) three Open heifers (Purebreds and/or crossbreds), Females 15-24 months of age on or before December 31, 2015
- **Division III: American Breeds;** Pen of (3) three Bred Heifers (purebreds, crossbreds and F1s); Females 15-36 months of age on or before December 31, 2015. Consignors must provide pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner, licensed veterinarian at time females are processed at the show.
- **Division IV.** American Breeds; Pen of (3) three Open Heifers (purebreds, crossbreds and F1's), Females 15-24 months of age on or before December 31, 2015.

<u>Cattlemen's Day</u>: On December 29, 2015 the Arizona National Livestock Show will showcase this significant industry of Arizona and anticipate more than 300 Cattlemen and their families will join us for the Brisket Lunch sponsored and served by the Arizona Farm Bureau. The Ranch Replacement Female Show and Sale will take place at 1:30 pm this day. Of special note is the feature of our Arizona Working Ranch Horse Competition and Sale on the same day.

<u>Special Events</u>: Dutch Oven Cook Off, Chuck Wagon Cook Off, Cowboy Classics Western Art & Gear Show, AZ Working Ranch Horse Competition, Li'l Buckaroo Rodeo, Youth Pedal Tractor Pull, Farm Experience an interactive area for children to learn about agriculture, Educational Clinics, Livestock Judging Contests, FFA Public Speaking Contest, Skillathon, and other Junior Exhibitor Events.
