

Williamson County Fair Pageants

All contestants get a beautiful crown and a gorgeous rose



Participating builds self-esteem, confidence, and poise, as well as self discipline and character. The Williamson County Fair is gearing up for the elegant portion of the fair....the Williamson County Fair Pageants and Baby Contests, which will be held on Sunday, August 5, 2018. The Williamson County Fair Pageant system helps young women across Williamson County set goals for themselves and give them confidence to achieve their dreams. This not only gives the contestants confidence on how to carry themselves with stage experience, but also helps in many situations in a contestants young life.

The winner of the Fairest of the Fair competition, ages 16-21, will go on to compete at the Tennessee State Fairest of the Fair in Nashville in January, 2019. She will receive a Crown, Sash, Trophy, and a \$250 savings bond. The Williamson County Fair will pay for room and board at the State Pageant, as well as provide \$200 for expenses. All contestants will receive a Rhinestone Crown and a Beautiful Rose. 1st and 2nd runners up will also receive a beautiful crown.

The Petite Miss, ages 4-6, Little Miss, ages 7-9, Junior Miss, ages 10-12, and Teen Miss, ages 13-15, divisions also compete during the Williamson County Fair. All contestants will receive a Rhinestone Crown and a Beautiful Rose. All titleholders will receive a Crown, Sash, Trophy, and a \$250 savings bond, and will represent the Williamson County Fair. 1st and 2nd runners up will also receive a beautiful crown.

Baby Contest divisions are 0-12 months, 12-24 months, and the Toddler Division 2-3 years, with girls and boys competing in all three divisions as follows: Baby Miss and Baby Mister, 0-12 months; Tiny Miss and Tiny Mister, 12-24 months; and Toddler Miss and Toddler Mister, 2-3 years old. All contestants will receive a Rhinestone Crown and a Beautiful Rose. All Baby Contest titleholders will receive a Crown, Sash, and Trophy and will represent the Williamson County Fair. 1st and 2nd runners up will also receive a beautiful crown.

All the pageant fun will be held Sunday, August 5th in the Performing Arts Center at Academy Park, 112 Everbright Avenue, Franklin, TN. A Modeling Workshop for all contestants will be held Saturday, August 4th, 3:00-5:00 pm at the Performing Arts Center. Attendance is not mandatory.

- The Baby Contest arrival time is 1:30 pm with pageants starting at 2:00 pm...0-12 month first, 12-24 month next, followed by 2-3 year Toddler.
- Petite Miss arrival time 2:30 pm; pageant begins at 3:00 pm
- Little Miss arrival time 3:30 pm; pageant begins at 4:00 pm
- Junior Miss arrival time 4:30 pm; pageant begins at 5:00 pm
- Teen Miss arrival time 5:30 pm; pageant begins at 6:00 pm
- Fairest of the Fair Interview arrival time 11:30 am; Interviews begin at Noon
 - o Pageant arrival time 6:00 pm; pageant begins at 7:00 pm

Entry fee is \$25 for contestants in all divisions, and entries are due in the Fair Office no later than Friday, August 3, 2018. Entry forms and information are available online at www.williamsoncountyfair.org.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All Contestants must be full-time residents of Williamson County.
- 2. All contestants will receive a beautiful rhinestone crown and rose.
- 3. Age Requirements:

a. Petite Miss
b. Little Miss
c. Junior Miss
d. Teen Miss
e. Fairest of the Fair
Ages 4-6 on the day of the contest
Ages 7-9 on the day of the contest
Ages 10-12 on the day of the contest
Ages 13-15 on the day of the contest
Age 16, but not 21, by December 31, 2017

- 4. Pageants will be held at the Performing Arts Center at Academy Park, 112 Everbright Avenue, Franklin, TN.
- 5. Entry forms are available at www.williamsoncountyfair.org or may be picked up at the Fair Office at the Ag Expo Park on or after July 23rd.
- 6. The Fair reserves the right to see proof of age (birth certificate) upon request.
- 7. Contestant must never have been married, had a child, have a record, or have been convicted of a felony.
- 8. Sportsmanship and manners are required of all contestants.
- 9. Dress guidelines are as follows:
 - a. Fairest of the Fair (16-21) Dress must be formal and floor-length pageant dress. Interview suite or dress will be required for interview and same will be worn on stage during the beginning of the pageant.
 - b. Teen Miss (13-15) Dresses can be long or short and can be a formal floor length pageant dress. Makeup is allowed.
 - c. Junior Miss (10-12) Dresses should be dressy, no pageant wear, no rhinestones or sequins, no makeup.
 - d. Little Miss (7-9) Dresses should be dressy. No pageant wear, no rhinestones or sequins, no strapless, no high heels, no makeup.
 - e. Petite Miss (4-6) Dresses should be dressy, no pageant wear, no rhinestones or sequins, no strapless, no heels, no makeup.
- 10. The judges' decision will be final. No refunds will be given.
- 11. Only Fairest of the Fair contestants have an interview competition added to their score of 25%. All divisions are scored on poise and personality, inner beauty, and overall appearance.
- 12. Only one (1) chaperone is allowed in the dressing room with the contestant.
- 13. Winners must be willing to represent the Williamson County Fair at different events if called on to do so.
- 14. The Fairest of the Fair is expected to attend the Tennessee Association of Fairs Convention in Nashville in January, 2019. If she cannot attend the State Fairest of the Fair contest, she must relinquish her crown to the first runner up who will become the new Fairest of the Fair. The Williamson County Fair will furnish room and board, plus \$200 for expenses at the State contest.
- 15. A Modeling Workshop will be held on Saturday, August 4th from 3:00-5:00 pm for all contestants to practice walking on the stage. Attendance is not mandatory. It will be held at the Performing Arts Center at Academy Park.
