THESE CARDS MUST BE TURNED IN WITH YOUR LIVESTOCK ENTRY(s). There will be a penalty of a \$200 marketing fee per lot sold for any exhibitor not turning in the cards with their entry. This fee will be deducted from the exhibitors JLA check.

Example of Presentation:

Hi, I am (your name) _____ and I would like to take a few minutes to tell you about what I do as a livestock exhibitor at the Amador County Fair.

I am a member of (Club name) ____ raising (animal type) ____ for the 2012 Fair. I have to carefully monitor all the care and feeding for my project. Strict rules are followed in the raising of my animal to ensure the best results. The animal is pre-weighed at 120 or 60 days (whichever time frame applies to your animal) and must gain a minimum of 20% in weight by the official weigh-in at the Fair. This makes sure that the animal is getting enough food and growing to the prime weight. I have to keep accurate records, which will help me learn the financial principles with the project. This education will be very helpful as I grow into adulthood.
