RULES

- 1. One entry per person.
- 2. Must be original work of contestant, no stencils or kits permitted.
- 3. Art supplies should be used such as paint, markers, crayons, etc.
- 4. NO CARVING.
- 5. NO ACCESSORIES SUCH AS EARRINGS, EYES OR HATS ATTACHED TO PUMPKIN. (If any attachments are used, the pumpkin will automatically be disqualified.)
- 6. Natural or artificial pumpkins will be allowed. NO JACK-A-LATERNS ACCEPTED.

WHERE

1. Bring decorated pumpkin, with entry form, between **3:00 PM** and **5:30 PM**, Thursday, October 31st. *PLEASE NOTE: Step one- Drop off entry at Premium Building; Step two- move vehicle to north parking lot Alfa entrance; Step three- return to <i>Premium Building to complete paper work/check –in.* No entries will be accepted any other time.

Originality: 20 points
 Artistic Design: 20 points
 Suitability of pumpkin to design: 10 points
 TOTAL: 50 points
