PASSES

General Exhibits:

Exhibitors in Open/Youth Home Arts, Floriculture, Valley Produce, & 4-H General: Processing Fee of \$8.00 will be charged. One (1) pass will be assigned to each exhibitor that pays the \$8.00 fee. For the \$8.00 fee, exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as they wish within the Modern Living Building (Foods, Fabrics, Crafts, Floriculture). Ag Building, you may enter as many as you wish in Valley Produce. Please see Photo and Fine Arts for their fees. No cross over between buildings. The Livestock Department is not included in this program.

JUDGING: The judging process for our Photography Department takes a lot of time due to the large amount of entries that are submitted. Our judging staff takes the time to critique the entries; however there is not enough time for them to do written evaluations. All entries will be judged.

SYSTEM OF JUDGING: Amateur divisions will be judged Danish and professional divisions will be judged American.

PROCESSING FEE:

<u>Professional:</u> \$11.00 for the first exhibit entry, \$3.00 per additional entry.

Amateur: \$8.00 – You may enter two (2) prints for the \$8.00 fee. Additional prints will be \$2.00 each for a maximum of ten (10) prints. One (1) pass will be assigned to each exhibitor who pays the \$8.00 fee; no additional passes will be given. No crossover entries to other departments.

RELEASING:

Monday, October 1^{st} , 9:00am to 5:30pm. Exhibits left after October 1^{st} will be disposed of. Please make arrangements with the Superintendent if you cannot pick them up.

<u>Amateur</u>: Blue – \$4.00, Red – \$2.00, White – \$0.00 <u>Professional</u>: 1st - \$25.00, 2nd - \$15.00, 3rd - \$10.00

Best of Class: Rosette for each class. Amateur Best of Show: \$20.00 & Rosette Professional Best of Show: \$50.00 & Rosette

OPEN PHOTOGRAPHY GENERAL RULES

Please read the General Information, Rules and Regulations of the Fair.

 Amateurs must enter in amateur division, professionals in professional division.

Professional: Those whose work is produced for the purpose of selling, or who have a diploma, certificate, degree, or have three or more years of training, or teach in their media.

Amateur: Does the work for the pleasure involved; receive no money for their work; and has had little or no training.

- All photos must be taken by entrant and be suitable for a family
- Only work completed within the last year and not previously shown at the Central Washington State Fair is eligible.
- Both self-processed and commercially processed photos will be accepted.
- All entries must be a single photo; no collages will be accepted.
- Prints must be mounted or matted using lightweight mounting board, or mat board, or up to 10mm lamination to be suitable for hanging with Velcro. Due to hanging methods, prints under glass, framed, or with hanging tabs will not be accepted.

- Overall size of exhibit must be at least 8" x 10" and no larger than 11" x 14" (Amateur Only) or 16"x20" (Professional Only) including matting. If we do not have enough space to hang all of the entered photos, blue ribbon photos will be hung and displayed first.
- Your name, address, phone number and title of print must be on the back of your entry.
- Entries must be classified on entry form.
- All possible care will be taken to safeguard the entries, but no responsibility will be taken for loss or damage.
- Best of Class placing will use the American System of Judging whereas only one entry will receive the award chosen from all entries. No premiums will be given for Best of Class. All entries will be judged.

- No water marks or business identification on images.

OPEN SCRAPBOOKING GENERAL RULES

Please read the General Information, Rules and Regulations of the Fair.

- Page must be encased in a page protector covering which will have Velcro placed on the back of for hanging. Velcro is not removable
- Hint: Keep page protectors for use with your future entries.
- The pages will be judged on layout design not photos. Page must include photo(s) and journaling, or will not be judged. Page(s) will be scored on appearance, design and journaling.
- Ten (10 total) scrapbook pages may be entered per exhibitor.
 Due to the space limitations all of your pages may not be displayed, however they will be judged.
- Page must either be 7" x 7", 8½" x 11" or 12" x 12" single page only – two-page spreads will be judged separately.
- Adult and youth enter together.

- Print must be mounted or matted using light weight cardboard, mounting board or mat board, to be suitable for hanging with Velcro. Due to hanging method, prints under glass, framed or with hanging tabs will not be accepted.
- Overall size of exhibit must be at least 8" x 10" and no larger than 11" x 14"including matting. Entries will be displayed as room permits. Blue ribbon photos will be hung and displayed first. All entries will be judged.
