

Chris Grant is a farmer, writer, speaker, and professional bingo player. From Essex Massachusetts, Chris graduated from Essex Agricultural & Technical High School in 2008 and went on to earn an Associates degree in fruit and vegetables crops at The Stockbridge School of Agriculture in 2010 and a Bachelors degree in Plant, Soil, & Insect Sciences from The University of Massachusetts Amherst in 2012.

Chris started Grant's Plants in 2006 as his FFA supervised agricultural



experience, and has since turned it into his full time career as Grant Family Farm in Essex, where they grow vegetables, cut flowers, eggs, and poultry for farmers markets, restaurants, and food cooperatives across the North Shore. In 2013 Chris released his first book Fears of a Wantrepreneur, chronicling his experiences as a young entrepreneur, fear, and how to overcome all the obstacles that life throws at you with a little sense of humor.

Chris is a member of the Topsfield Fair Poultry Committee, Essex County Farm Bureau board of directors, Massachusetts Young Farmers & Ranchers Committee, Chris Grant cont'd Stockbridge School of Agriculture Board, chairman of Sustainable Horticulture advisory board at Essex Technical High School and a big brother in the Big Brothers Big Sisters Program.

When Chris is not at a farmers market, on his farm, speaking, or attending meetings wearing his trademark chicken ties, you can find him being a normal 27 year old hiking, traveling, or working on his next book.

Chris Grant Speaking Intro Today's speaker is a little different than the ones we have had in the past.

He started his business at the age of 16, published a book at 23, today he's a 27 year old chicken farmer

who still uses his moms Netflix account.

If you missed him on Good Morning America or the Today Show, it's probably because he's never been invited to be on them.
