Important Details & Changes:

- Any youth or adult cattle are welcome to arrive Friday. Please just let me know if you are a Sunday exhibitor planning to come in Friday so there is enough stall space designated
- Brown Swiss, Holsteins and Milking Shorthorns will show Saturday and must be stalled by 7AM Saturday morning. These animals will be released Saturday at 5 PM
- Ayrshire, Guernseys, and Jerseys will show Sunday. These animals can arrive Friday anytime or Saturday after 6PM. These animals will be released Sunday at 5PM
- Because of the stall turn over please make sure you leave stalls clean.

Please note: The Fair is piloting a new schedule for showing this year. Feedback and recommendations are welcomed by show superintendent. Any animal youth or adult is welcome to arrive starting Friday.

RULES FOR THE EXHIBITION OF CATTLE

- 1. All cattle must be from an accredited herd or have passed tuberculin test within 60 days.
- 2. Any animal showing signs of any communicable diseases will be barred.
- 3. The Society reserves the right to reject any or all entries and will not accept entries in excess of the accommodations.
- 4. Each animal must have a sign or card over its stall showing name, date of birth, name of sire and dam.
- 5. No animal shall receive a prize unless worthy of it.
- 6. Brucellosis must come from a certified herd or be tested within 30 days.
- 7. All animals must be accompanied by registration papers
- 8. The Cattle Committee may limit the number of animals shown by an exhibitor in a class and determine eligibility of all entries.
- 9. Interfering with the Judge is prohibited.
- 10. Animals and exhibits must be kept clean and neat at all times.
- 11. Per Order of the Northampton Fire Department:
 - No Cooking in Any Barns
 - All Electrical Cords Must be 3 Prong
 - All Fans Must Be 3 Wire Grounded Plugs

*****NO CLIPPING CHUTES IN BARNS*****

PLEASE LEAVE PEN AND STALL AREAS CLEAN WHEN LEAVING

NO DUMPING OF WATER BUCKETS IN PENS AND STALLS

EXHIBITORS STANDARDS

The Fair is an educational activity. Fairs should establish discretionary standards for dress. Positive social behavior, good sportsmanship and cooperation should be encouraged. It is recognized that in classes of livestock, exhibitors have standards of dress which have been accepted by the industry; white or khaki slacks, white skirts or dresses and white shirts (no farm names allowed on clothing). No shorts or bathing attire will be allowed. A solid, durable shoe must be worn at all times while on the grounds. No sandals, clogs, or bare feet will be allowed. Failure to comply with these rules will mean forfeit of all premiums.

DAIRY CATTLE SHOW RULES

- 1. Base date for computing ages: All breed March 1st and September 1st
- 2. All breeds are classified the same but shown separately. Holstein, Guernsey, Brown Swiss, Ayrshire, Jersey and Milking Shorthorn.
- 3. Individual classes will be limited to 2 entries per class per exhibitor.
- 4. Group classes will be limited to 1 entry per class per exhibitor. <u>One entry per family or farm</u>.
- 5. All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in their individual classes.
- 6. Best Uddered only one per exhibitor. <u>One entry per family or farm.</u>
