



Empty Bowls Jr. 2020 Funding Application

Brazos Valley Educators, KAGS, KBTX, Bryan Broadcasting Company, Allen Honda and The Arts Council have teamed up to raise funds through the Empty Bowls, Jr. event in support of Brazos Valley school food pantries. These awards can be used for facility needs as well as food supplies. Award recipients will be notified by February 14, 2020. Funding distribution will occur in late-March to early-April 2020. School food pantries in the Brazos Valley are encouraged to apply for funding.

To be considered for funding from this program:

- Pantry/program must be an approved USDA food pantry
- Pantry/program must be a Brazos Valley Food Bank affiliate
- Supporting school/applicant must provide artistic bowls for event
- Supporting school/applicant must provide volunteers for event (Saturday, February 29th, 11am-1:30pm to assist with set up and tear down)
- Applicant must be an authorized representative of food pantry or school
- Completed form and a **signed, current W9** must be submitted to The Arts Council by **Monday, February 3rd, 2020 at 5 pm.**
