etc. Just remember, you will need to be able to transfer your design to a wooden surface and designs must be stable enough to hang on a wall display so craft accordingly.

4. Is it free to enter?

Yes! All ages are welcome to enter and participation is free.

5. How many mask designs can we enter?

You can enter as many mask designs as you like!

6. Could we donate the mask back to The Arts Council to auction off?

Sure. We're more than happy to take your wonderful mask-erpiece off your hands!

7. Can we write a song, poem, or phrase we wrote on our mask?

8. Can we use Disney characters on the mask?

No, this is an example of copyrighted designs that are ineligible for submission into our mask contest. Create freely, but be sure that the work is original!
