ACTIVE DRUG INGREDIENT

LASALOCID 59 GM/TON

Caution:

The safety of Lasalocid in unapproved species has not been established. Do not allow horses or other equine access to Lasalocid as ingestion may be fatal. This feed contains 29.5mg of Lasalocid per pound of feed. Feed continuously at the rate of no less than 60mg (2.1 pounds of feed) nor more than 300mg (10.25 pounds of feed) of Lasalocid per head per day. The use of this drug will not affect reproductive performance of cattle. There is no slaughter withdrawal period when using this drug.

Feeding Directions:

Formax Stocker 13% with Bovatec is one of our most popular feeds. A very inexpensive pelleted feed that can be used as a creep feed, bull feed, heifer feed or cow feed (Except for lactating Dairy animals, which it is NOT labeled for). This feed will provide energy, protein, minerals, and vitamins to cattle that are fed on a daily basis. This feed can be fed up to 1.5% of the body weight of the animal for cattle weighing less than 700 pounds and up to 10.25 pounds per head per day on heavier cattle. This feed makes an excellent creep feed and will work very well through a creep feeder. Creep feeding calves can be beneficial to the producer when the cost of a pound of gain is less than the market value of that calf. Five pounds of this feed should produce one pound of gain for your calves being creep fed. This feed also will work very well as a starter feed for calves that are being weaned. Bovatec is added to promote growth, increase feed efficiency, and reduce the incidence of coccidiosis. Bovatec will not affect

reproduction, therefore this feed can be fed to all classes of cattle (except lactating dairy cattle) as a feed supplement. This feed should not be fed free choice to weaned calves or mature animals. Do not feed to horses. Do not feed to sheep due to levels of copper. When feeding breeding stock, remember that excess fat can lead to poor reproductive performance, therefore, feed heifers an amount of not more than 1.5% of their body weight ($600\text{lb} \times 1.5\% = 9\text{lb}$ of feed) This product should be fed in a bunk feeder due to small pellet size.

Important Management Practices

Provide a source of fresh clean water and free choice mineral at all times. When making any change in an animal's diet, plan a 7 to 10 day transition period. Provide ample feeder space of 18 inches per animal. Feeders should protect feed from becoming wet and moldy. Poorly managed feeding programs can increase the possibility of feeding disorders.
