

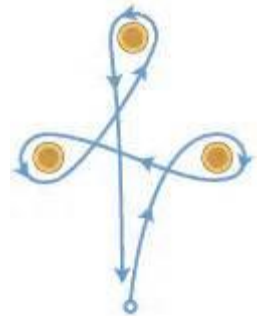

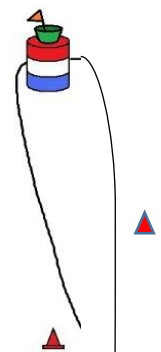
RULES AND GUIDELINES

Events for ages 9 & under

Cloverleaf Barrels – The miniature barrels (3) are set up in the arena in a cloverleaf pattern. The rider must come into the arena and run their horse around each barrel in a cloverleaf pattern without knocking them over and then back to the alley with great speed as this is a timed event. A five second penalty is assessed for each barrel knocked over or missed. Drawing of the pattern is below. Fastest time wins.



Flag Race - One barrels will be placed in the arena with a flag. Contestants will ride their stick horses to the barrel, retrieve the flag and then ride back to the starting line to finish. This is a timed event. Fastest time wins.



Events for 18 & under – Fastest time wins in all events

Dummy Roping – The contestant will begin from an entry line, run up to the dummy and throw the rope without breaking the barrier (crossing the finish line). Crossing the line will add 5 seconds to the final time. Time will stop when the calf head dummy has been roped and the slack has been drawn.

Goat Tying – The contestant will begin at the starting line and run to the goat staked at the opposite end of the arena. They will gently flip the goat and tie 3 of the goat's legs with a goat string or piggin' string. Time will stop when the contestant raises their hands. The goat must stay tied for 5 seconds or the exhibitor will receive a no time.

Goat Team Roping – Come with a partner or we can give you one but bring your own ropes. Each team has a header and a heeler. Header nods head and goat is released. Being careful not to break the barrier both team members must chase goat on foot. Header must rope the goats head before heeler can rope the heels. Broken barrier adds 10 seconds to the final time. The time will end once the back legs are stretched. Only catching one leg will add 5 seconds to the final time. If the header misses the heeler may head and then the header may rope the hind legs. Two misses will end that run for the ropers.

Ages will be divided on the day of the rodeo based on the participants entered.

Registration and Entry Fees accepted the day of the events.
