MEAT PEN DEFINITION: A Meat Pen will consist of three rabbits of the same color, preferably of the same breed, but mixed breeds will be acceptable. The animals must weigh at least 3 ½ pounds and no more than 5 ½ pounds each. Rabbits cannot be over ten weeks old. Animals may come from different litters. The trio should be uniform.

- 1. TATTOOS:** Meat Pens must have special Arkansas State Fair tattoo in the right ear. In the left ear – rabbits must have an individual rabbit identification number – issued by the exhibitor.

ONLY TATTOO LOCATION

Saturday, September 14 at the Arkansas State Fairgrounds on Dock between

Cattle Barn 3 & 4 from 10 AM until 4 PM

- 2. DUAL ENTRY:** Rabbits entered in the Single Fryer Competition cannot be entered as part of a Meat Pen trio. **Exception:** A meat pen entered that has a mortality that would disqualify the entry, may have one rabbit designated by owner and signed by agent/advisor to be moved to single fryer. Only one meat pen entry is eligible for this exception. This must be done two days before show date.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries an exhibitor can submit for Meat Pen Contest. **Entries will be done online.** The entry site is on our website www.arkansasstatefair.com. Refer to the Livestock tab, then proceed to 2019 ShoWorks Online Entry Site for Breeding, Dairy, and Rabbits.
4. Meat Pen entries must be entered no later than September 15th. Entry Fee is \$20 per pen.
5. **THERE WILL BE AN OFFICIAL SIFT DURING CHECK IN. YOU MUST BRING YOUR MEAT PEN TRIO TO BE WEIGHED BY AN OFFICAL ARKANSAS STATE FAIR RABBIT COMMITTEE MEMBER. EACH RABBIT MUST WEIGH AT LEAST 3 ½ POUNDS AND NO MORE THAN 5 ½.**
6. The Grand Champion Meat Pen will be in the Sale of Champions on Friday, October 18th at 2 PM. The Junior Exhibitor of the Champions must be present.

7. The Grand Champion Meat Pen will receive a Purple Circle Award.
8. Participants in the Meat Pen Competition are eligible to compete in Junior Rabbit Showmanship. No entry fee or entry form is required to compete in the Showmanship Competition.

7. False risers are allowed and may be brought for any breed. Measurements are: 22 ½" X 25".
8. When entering, rabbits age should be based on how old they will be on October 12, 2019.
9. Entry must designate which show is being entered, Show A or B. Separate entry and payment for each show is required.

All exhibitors who enter the Arkansas State Fair Rabbit show must have a signed Junior Exhibitor Signature form on file by September 1, 2019. Junior Exhibitors must be a bona fide member of an Arkansas 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.
