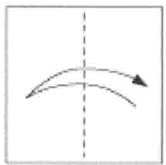

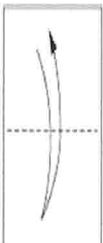
Cut along the edges of the Cootie Catcher



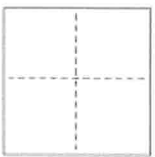
Fold along the horizontal line



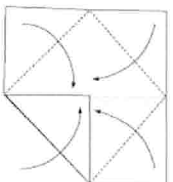
Fold along the vertical line



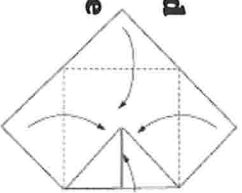
Open it all up and flip it text down on the desk



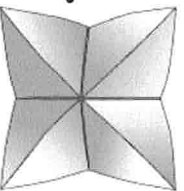
Fold each corner to the center



Flip over and fold each corner to the center

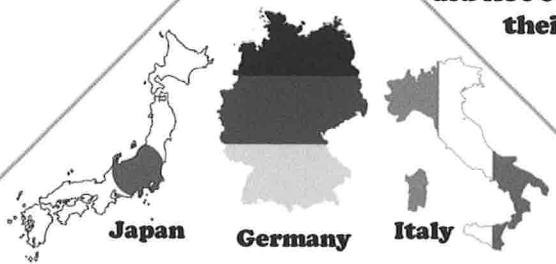


Fold in half and put your fingers under the flaps

An attack on Hawaii by Japan on the U.S. This attack prompted the United States to enter World War II

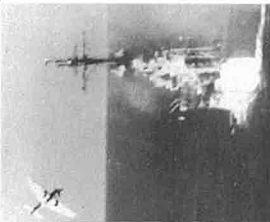








Battle of the Bulge
