

WELCOME to Benton Oaks RV & Campground!

The camp host will ensure an enjoyable stay for all by enforcing the following rules:

Check out time is 12:00 noon

Early arrivals or late departures will be assessed a fee equal to an additional day of rental, unless prior arrangements have been made with the camp host.

Check in time is 2:00 pm

he maximum number of RVs per site is one; the maximum number of vehicles is two. RV sites should not exceed 6 people each; tents limited to 4 people each.

Campsite: We reserve the right to change site bookings. We will try our best to place you in the site that you request; however, occasionally adjustments have to be made to accommodate special needs. **Please keep your camp clean** and free of debris and clutter. Trash is to be disposed of in the dumpster and recycling containers at the edge of the RV Park (behind A11). Mechanical work on vehicles is not allowed. **Current license plates must be maintained on your RV.** **Your motor home or trailer must be fully functional and able to be moved if necessary.** Proper sewer connections must be maintained or a tank attached and dumped regularly (if in Overflow). In the full-service sites, RVs must pull through or back into the space so that the driver's side of the vehicle faces the sewer hook ups. Cars left unattended in RV sites are subject to be towed at the owners' expense. RVs with levelers must use blocks. The camp host can loan blocks if needed.

Tent Camping: Tent camping is limited to Memorial Day through Labor Day with a five night maximum stay (within a 30 day period), unless prior arrangements have been made with the camp host or Event Center Office.

Children: Campers under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. After 9:00 pm, children should be at their assigned site.

Pets: Maximum 3 pets per campsite. Pets must be kept on a leash or inside a vehicle. Do not leave your pet unattended at your campsite. All vaccinations must be up-to-date and dogs must display current registration tags. Campers are responsible for removal and disposal of pet waste.

Restrooms and showers are for use by paying campers only. Non-guests pay \$5 per shower. Public Nudity is not allowed. Let us know if these facilities need service. Please do not wash clothes or dishes in the restrooms. Gray water receptacles are located in the camping area.

Laundry Facilities are for paying campers only. Washing pet bedding, blankets and equipment is not allowed.

Please Protect the Oaks: Vehicles must stay clear from under oak trees out to the drip line of the branches, except on roadways or in designated camp spaces. The root system of these trees is fragile and damaged by the weight of vehicles.

Fires: When not banned by the Fire Marshall, fires are allowed in charcoal grills or fire pits elevated off the grass, not supplied by the Fairgrounds; check with Camp Host.

Rental Events occasionally occur on the Fairgrounds that may interfere or conflict with camping. These events are part of the value of your stay with us. Please be aware of these activities, as we do not refund camp fees if you later decide that your visit is being disturbed.

Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Dump Station is for paying guests. The fee for non-guests is \$5.00 per dump.

Cancellation Fees: If you need to cancel your reservation, you must call the campground before the deadline to receive your refund, less a \$15 cancellation fee. Email notifications of cancellations are not acceptable within 48 hours of your check-in time. We require 48 hours cancellation notification. Call the office by 4:00 pm two days before your scheduled arrival. Special weekends, including OSU home football games and graduation, require 7 days cancellation notice.

All Benton County property is smoke and tobacco free. Fireworks are prohibited.
