### Entry Procedures & Department Rules

1. **Please read all Livestock Rules on pages 38-39.**
2. Birds must be entered during intake hours and not removed until the release times. Any bird not removed during the scheduled release times becomes the property of the Fairgrounds.
2. Registration deadline is July 19, 2019 to the Benton County Fair Open Class Exhibit Coordinator.
3. Entries limited to 10 entries or as space allows.
4. Birds will have a health inspection at intake and those that are sick or are infested with lice or mites will not be accepted and will forfeit any and all entry fees.
5. No poultry may be entered in both the open class and 4-H division.
6. All poultry entered in open class are subject to use for judging contests and/or rooster crowing contests.
7. The poultry will be judged under American Poultry Association Rules.
8. All birds must have an identifying leg band. Bands are available at check in.
9. Birds improperly entered will be disqualified.
10. Water and feed will be provided by Benton County Fair & Rodeo.
12. No bird under 6 months old can be entered.
13. The superintendent has the right to excuse any exhibitor as needed for violating the rules.
