Building Theme: Best Week of Summer, Feed a Bee, Feed a Community, Feed the World!

1. Before entering, refer to General Information.
2. Entry forms are due to the Fair Office no later than 8/1. Entry forms must include the same information as required on labels.
3. Entries are to be received no later than 5 p.m. Fri., 8/10, at the Benton-Franklin Fair Office, 1500 S. Oak St., Kennewick.
4. Entrants must be at least 21 years old to submit an entry. Entries from minors will not be accepted.
5. Submit three bottles of wine for each entry; two for judging and one for display. All entries must be labeled with the name of the winemaker, city and state, class number, vintage year, and ingredients. (Example: John Smith, Pasco, WA, Lot #1, 2007, 100% Cabernet Sauvignon.) Label must be at least 2" wide by 3" high and be secured to the bottle by adhesive. Entry size is standard 750 ml bottles. (Port or dessert wine may be in 375ml bottles.) Bottle displays and ribbons must be picked up between 8 a.m.-10 a.m. on Sunday, 8/26, in Bldg. 1.
6. Best of Show Wine Label Contest. All wine entries will be eligible. Labels can either incorporate the required entry information or be an additional "contest" label. Traditional painted and etched are allowed. A "contest" label may only be applied to the display bottle.
7. Judging will be completed prior to the Fair opening. Judging notes will be on display during the Fair.
8. Changing entry after receipt by superintendent will result in disqualification.

Labels are judged on the following: Size, Shape, Composition and General Appearance
