3. Exhibitor has pre-entered in this department and will select the division and class at time of judging. Exhibitor will be required to complete a separate form for each division that they enter.
4. Pictures and hanging items must be ready to display. Clothing needs to be hung on a hanger so that it can be easily hung on the wall or a clothes bar.
5. Each entry is judged on an individual basis and not judged against other entries.
