1. Before entering, refer to General Information.
2. Exhibits to arrive on grounds between 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Sun., 8/19. No exhibits will be accepted after that time. Exhibits must be picked up between 8-10 a.m. Sun., 8/26.
3. LIMIT: Five entries per class, per exhibitor.
4. All competitive pieces must be the handiwork of the exhibitor, completed in the past year, and not exhibited previously at the Benton Franklin Fair. Entries must be done on cast earthen greenware, clay thrown on a wheel, or hand-built from pottery clay which has been fired and decorated, and ready for exhibit. Enter only one piece of set (e.g. canisters) except nativities and chess sets, which must be entered entirely. Plates or plaques must be on a stand for display. Do not put felt on bottom of pieces except for bookends and chess pieces (all bottoms must be finished).
5. Fused glass entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
