Before entering

Please refer to General Information for 4-H & FFA Livestock Departments, Livestock Rules and Regulations, Youth Rules, and Market Stock Rules. During the Fair It is important to check the goat information board in the barn for any changes. Please see Tag Day, Registration Dates and Entry Days for those times and locations.

1. Breeding Stock

- a. Due to the high risk of Q-Fever shedding in goats near kidding time, goats within 30 days before or after giving birth will not be allowed into the fair.
- b. All dairy goats must have a required USDA or WSDA Scrapie Eradication Flock ID Tag or registered Tattoo.
- c. Goat(s) must be checked by the official Fair Veterinarian prior to unloading. The Fair veterinarian's professional decisions to the health status of an animal are FINAL.

2. Limit of 5 goats per exhibitor (no companions or goats not entered in the fair).

5. FFA (must have been enrolled in project year prior to fair)

Entries are limited to 4-H and FFA members living in or attending school in Benton or Franklin counties or the Burbank School District.

Does entered in these classes are not required to be Breed Registered. Each doe should be entered in the breed she most closely represents. If she obviously has characteristics of two breeds, you may enter her in the crossbreed class. Contact Superintendent for assistance. 4-H Goat Certificate required to be turned into the Kennewick extension office by June 15.

6. Dry yearling, 18 months and under 24 months, never kidded, never in milk

12. Does, 5 years and older, having kidded, in milk (refer to rule #5-J)

16. Get-of-Sire, to consist of three does, the get of the same sire, at least one having freshened. (refer to rule #5-J)
15. Dairy herd, to consist of three does having freshened. All exhibits must be individual; exhibitors must be directly responsible for animals. (refer to rule #5-J)
