4-H IN ACTION

A one or two-hour event to share an activity with the public, any subject. This activity is judged daily. Guidelines for this activity are available from the superintendent or the Cooperative Extension Office. Pre-registration is required. A PA system, table and easels will be available. You will be required to provide all additional equipment needed. Video photography projects may be included in this class. Building herdsmanship is a four-hour event with three or six club members to share activity (interaction) with the public on any 4-H subject/project in the 4-H/FFA building.
