1. Before entering refer to General Information and Youth Rules.
2. Animals to arrive on the grounds before 8 a.m. Sat., 8/25.
3. Judging to take place at 9 a.m. beginning with 4-H Fitting and Showing; Open Class Cat Show to follow.
4. No kittens under age of four (4) months may enter.
5. All vaccinations should be current. If your cat is sick or recovering from an illness, please leave it at home. Remember, the health of the cat is the most important thing to consider. Check with your vet if you have any questions.
6. All claws must be clipped before the animals are judged.
7. De-Clawed cats are welcome to enter.
8. Cats should be clean and free from fleas, ear mites, ring worm, etc.
9. Please bring food, dishes, litter and pan. Also bring a cover for the top and three sides of the cage. Cages are provided and are approx. 30" long X 19" wide and 21" high. Contact Superintendent for exact measurements.
10. Each cat must have its own leash and harness. Collars are not acceptable. The Fair will not be responsible for animals that are lost or escape from the cages.
11. Registration papers are not needed for purebred cats. TICA or CFA confirmation standards are NOT being used for purebred judging.
12. All cats, purebred and mixed breeds, will be judged on health, beauty, personality and condition.
13. LIMIT: Three cats per exhibitor.
