All exhibitors will be required to sign a release form regarding their birds health before their fowl will be allowed into the building.

1. Before entering, refer to General Information, Livestock Rules and Regulations, and Herdsmanship.
2. Cage fee per single entry is \$1, nonrefundable and due with entry fee. Exhibitors will receive a five-day pass to care for their own exhibits.
3. Animals to arrive on grounds Mon., 8/20, between 10 a.m.-8 p.m. Birds to be released Sun., 8/26, between 8 a.m.-10 a.m. Not responsible for birds left after 10 a.m.
4. LIMIT: 20 entries per exhibitor. Entries based on a first-come, first-serve basis, with 4-H given first priority. Barn capacity is 700 birds (poultry, game and cage birds). Game birds are limited to five per exhibitor, preferably cock birds.
5. Judging time to be announced later.
6. Absolutely no barn birds.
7. All exhibitors must provide their own feed, grit and shavings for the entire week. Shavings will be available for purchase at the Fair Office, or you may bring your own. All livestock exhibitors will be subject to a \$5 bedding fee, which includes one bag of shavings.
8. Superintendent is not responsible for providing or caring for supplies or equipment.
8. All birds must be banded.
