1. Before entering, refer to General Information and Livestock Rules and Regulations.
2. Cage fees: \$1 per rabbit; \$1 per fur class; \$1 single fryers and \$2 per meat pen. Fees are non-refundable and due with entry fee. Exhibitors will receive a five-day pass to care for their animals.
3. Animals to arrive on grounds between 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Mon., 8/20. All rabbits must be removed between 8-10 a.m. Sun., 8/26.
4. Not to exceed 8 entries total for the department. Barn will be limited to the first 400 animals entered, with 4-H, FFA and youth open exhibitors given first priority.
5. Judging will begin at 9 a.m. Tue., 8/21. You must be present to carry your own rabbit or make other arrangements. No carriers will be available.
6. Interpretations of these rules shall be vested in the show committee. Their decision, in conjunction with the fair board, is final.
7. Rabbits must be entered in actual owner's name. If owned in partnership, they must be entered as such.
8. No substitutes allowed, except in same breed, sex and class, unless authorized by the barn Superintendent.
9. The current ARBA rules will be used in this show.
10. Does with litters will not be accepted.
11. Contact superintendent if help is needed with feeding and watering. Owners must supply own feed and make proper arrangements. All possible precautions will be taken to safeguard the animals.
12. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and shavings for the entire week. All livestock exhibitors will be subject to a \$5 bedding fee, which includes one bag of shavings.
12. Please note the Open Class Herdsmanship contest. Exhibitors will be enrolled and expected to fully participate.
13. Open Class Youth Showmanship takes place at 2 p.m. Thu., 8/23, following Cloverbud Showmanship. (See Department 39).
