All market goats are required to have official USD A Scrapie identification at fair weigh-in. A Producer Affidavit & Market Goat Health Record will be required before any goat is exhibited or sold. Food and Drug Administration Regulation, specifically, Title 21 Part 589.20000 of the Code of Federal Regulations (effective August 4, 1997) prohibits the feeding of ruminant proteins (i.e. meat and bone meal) to ruminant animals. NOTE: ALL MARKET ANIMALS ARE TERMINAL - NO TAKE HOMES ALLOWED
