Any deviation from the Benton Franklin Fair and/or Market Stock Rules, i.e., switching animals; will force the Board of Directors to take appropriate action. All market lambs are required to have official USDA Scrapie identification at fair weigh-in. A Market Sheep Health Record for Washington State will be required before any lamb is exhibited or sold. Food and Drug Administration Regulation, specifically, Title 21 Part 589.20000 of the Code of Federal Regulations (effective August 4, 1997) prohibits the feeding of ruminant proteins (i.e. meat and bone meal) to ruminant animals.
