

Volunteer Rules & Regulations

Volunteering is a partnership between you and the Bonner County Fair Board & Staff.

Our expectations from you are as follows:

- Perform your assignments to the best of your ability.
- Attend any and all trainings necessary for your volunteer assignment.
- Show up on time and stay for the length of your volunteer commitment.
- Treat every employee, exhibitor, volunteer, vendor, and fair patron with respect.
- No drugs or alcohol.
- Harassment or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Give notice if your availability changes as soon as possible.
- Be held accountable for your actions.
- Accept directions.
- To inform Fair Staff if you have any physical limitations, safety concerns, or are uncomfortable in any situation.
- Cooperate with other volunteers and staff; you are part of a team.
- Respect property, materials and equipment.
- Be open to change and ready to learn new skills.

What you can expect from us:

- To give you a sense of belonging to the project we assign.
- To provide sufficient training and orientation for you to carry out your volunteer role effectively.
- To offer you responsibilities that are challenging and yet within the range of your abilities and interest.
- To assign a position that has real purpose and is of value to you.
- To be clear in our expectations of you.
- To keep you informed.
- To respect your opinions and ideas and give them fair consideration.

Other Rules & Regulations:

- Volunteers must wear appropriate dress for the volunteer project. Comfort is key, but sometimes protective clothing will be required depending on the type of volunteer project.
- In case of bad weather, a project may be cancelled. Contact Fair Staff before arriving to ask if the
 project will be cancelled in case of rain or inclement weather. Often Fair Staff members are very
 creative in making the best use of your time on an indoor project instead.
- Superintendents must be 24 years or older.
- Superintendents must attend the lunch & training meeting on August 15, 2019.

All volunteers must complete and sign a Volunteer Liability Waiver. Young volunteers are required to have a parent/guardian consent and sign the waiver.
