RULES:

1. Read Open Class Creative Living Rules and Boulder County General Rules and Regulations are listed on the website.
2. When filling out entry form, **Needlecraft is Department 108.**
3. Articles in this department must have been completed within the last 2 years.
4. Articles must be entered in the name of the person who made them.
5. Write in the age of pre-teen/teen on the entry form. Pre-teens and Teens will be judged separately in all classes.
6. Exhibitors are encouraged to submit multiple entries in the same lot, however if making many similar articles, please limit yourself to 2 of that item. (Example: If you make 3 hats, please only enter 2.)
7. Please note that ribbons and monetary premiums will only be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
8. Depending on entries, superintendents will combine or divide lots to make sensible classes for judging.
9. Superintendent reserves the right to define classifications for all items entered.
10. Proper blocking, ironing and care of loose threads are very important.
11. Rugs must be finished on the underside.
12. Entries must be clean – or they will be disqualified.
13. Items are put on display for the length of the fair, Boulder County Fair or Superintendents are not to be held liable for soiling or loss of articles.
