7. All bulls 12 months or older must be shown with nose leads.
8. No Bulls in showmanship classes.
9. All animals must be registered and in good standing with AHCA and MSHCA.
10. Premiums: Premiums will be applied in a jackpot format. Winning will be dependent on entries in each class. Group Classes will have no premiums.
