**RULES:**

1. Read Open Class Creative Living Rules and Boulder County General Rules and Regulations listed on the website.
2. Please note that monetary premiums will only be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
3. When filling out entry form, **School Aged Art is Department 116**.
4. Please include grade on entry form. (School grade refers to grade completed in spring of fair year.)
5. The name, address, age and school grade of the child exhibiting must be placed on the BACK of each article exhibited.
6. Artwork must have been completed within the last year and all work must be originals, not copies.
7. All art work must be matted or mounted and have some means of hanging suitable for display on display boards - not to exceed 20" by 24" including mat or mount. We use push pins, staples, or bulldog clips and hooks to hang artwork on display boards. The Fair will NOT be responsible for damages. \*Pastels and watercolors may be covered with cellophane/plastic wrap.
8. All gluing on models must have been completed 1 week prior to fair, so it is absolutely dry.
9. Judging in this Department is NOT open to exhibitors or public due to space.

10. At the discretion of the Superintendents or Judges, exhibits may be reclassified.
11. Entries will be judged on the following: construction, general appearance, degree of difficulty and originality.
