

Boulder County Fair Junior Livestock Market Sale

What is a Junior Livestock Market Sale?

This sale consists of the livestock from the 4-H or FFA exhibitor's yearly projects consisting of beef, pigs, sheep, goats, dairy, rabbits and poultry. These programs are for youth from 8 – 18 teaching them proper care and feeding of a livestock project. The livestock lots are sold per head at a live auction with the sale of the animal going to the highest bidder. The proceeds from these sales go to the 4-H or FFA youth who in turn uses this money of pay for expenses on their projects and or to attend college.

How Can I Help?

You can purchase an animal at the sale. If you are unable to attend the sale, the committee will have someone do your bidding for you - just specifies what 4-H member or animal you want, and the price you are willing to pay. The terms of the sale are; cash or check at end of sale or billing to you or your business with preapproval. The Boulder County Fair is a non-profit 501(C)3 organization (Federal Tax ID# 84-1496078) and your donation may be tax deductible.

What do I do with the livestock I purchased?

You may elect to have your purchase custom processed for your personal use. The Committee has a list of custom processors in the area. Or you may consign your purchase back to the Boulder County Junior Market Livestock Sale Committee for resale at the stated market price on the sale day. If you use the resale option you only pay the difference between resale price and what your final bid was.

There is also the option to donate your purchase to those in need – Meals on Wheels, Wounded Warrior's and Community Food Share,
