Auction Rules

1. The entries in this department are subject to General Livestock, General Sales, and General Fair Rules printed in the current year catalog.
2. All projects in show are eligible for auction. Project must be in working condition and sold as shown including any winches, hydraulics, cylinders, batteries, etc. needed to make it functional and in good working condition.
3. A Sale Sheet Information Card will be provided for all Ag Mechanic Show Exhibitors. All exhibitors must complete and turn in the Sale Sheet Information Card at check-in to be eligible for auction. Sale Sheet Information Cards must be signed by group leader/teacher or parent (if individual exhibitor).
4. Checks will be issued to the same club/school or individual as on the entry form.
5. Individual projects are limited to one item in the auction. Club/group projects may have multiple items with duplicated exhibitors.
6. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to make arrangements with the buyer for pick-up or delivery of their project. Disposition papers will be given Sunday, October 18, 2020. All disposition paperwork must be accompanied by a stamped, fully addressed thank you card(s) to the buyer and to any additional add-ons and returned to the Fair Office by November 30, 2020 before a check will be released. Any disposition paperwork received after this date may not be paid.
7. All sellers in Auction must deliver or make arrangements for delivery of items sold to the buyer within seven days of the close of the fair. If there is a delay in delivery past seven days of the last of the fair, written notification of the reason for the delay and delivery arrangements must be given to the fair office. AG Mechanics Projects must be removed by 11 am Sunday, October 18, 2020.
8. The Ag Mechanics Auction committee will accept the sale order as presented from the Ag Mechanics project show.
9. Exhibitors must be present at time of auction.
10. A 5% sales fee will be charged by the Brazoria County Fair Association.
11. There is no minimum bid. All items must sell for price at auction.
12. Consequences for failure to comply with delivery rule will be loss of 50% net sale after 7 days and banned from participating in auctions the following year if not complied with delivery after 14 days.
13. W-9 forms must be completed by each exhibitor in order to pick up sale lot back numbers.

TERMS OF SALE: Payment is due at the close of the Auction. Cash, check, or credit cards will be accepted. Credit may be extended to previous fair buyers and to those who make arrangements with the General Sales Office prior to the auction. If proper credit approval is extended, the buyer will be sent a statement, which will be due and payable upon receipt. visa/mastercard/american express/discover accepted
