

Junior Commercial Heifer Auction

RULES

1. Entries in this auction are subject to General Livestock, General Sales, and General Fair Rules printed in the current year catalog.
 2. Only heifers in Department "C" are eligible for the Junior Commercial Heifer Auction. A 5% sales commission will be charged by Brazoria County Fair Association.
 3. PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE CLOSE OF THE AUCTION. All payment for heifers must be made to the Brazoria County Fair Association, Inc., who will in turn pay the individual.
 4. The Junior Commercial Heifer Auction will be held on Saturday, October 17, 2020 at 1 pm in the Auditorium.
 5. All Pens of Three qualifying to sell in the Commercial Heifer Auction will be videoed and sold by video. In the event of a death in a pen, the remaining heifers will still sell.
 6. The Commercial Heifer Auction Committee will accept the sale animals as presented from the Commercial Heifer Show Committee. All heifers presented by the Commercial Heifer Show Committee must sell or the exhibitor will be disqualified from being eligible to sell in the Commercial Heifer Auction the following year.
 7. If more than one entry makes the sale, the highest placing heifer must sell. In the event any exhibitor has more than one equal placing heifer eligible for the sale a decision must be made within 1 hour after the end of the Commercial Heifer Show by the exhibitor or representative as to which heifer will sell.
 8. W-9 forms must be completed by each exhibitor in order to pick up sale lot back numbers.
 9. All heifers that are over 12 months of age, as of October 1st, must be palpated. A statement indicating pregnancy status, signed by a licensed veterinarian, dated within 30 days prior to sale date must be presented at CHECK-IN.
 10. The number of heifers sold in the Auction will be determined by rule number 26 of the Commercial Heifer Show.
 11. All exhibitors selling in the Commercial Heifer Auction must be present on Sunday, October 18 to load and or deliver their animal and pick up disposition papers from auction. All disposition papers must be signed by the exhibitor and buyer. All signed disposition paperwork must be accompanied by a stamped, fully addressed thank you card(s) to the buyer and to any additional add-ons and returned to the fair office by November 30, 2020 before a check will be released. Any disposition paperwork received after this date may not be paid.
 12. All sellers in Auction must deliver or make arrangements for delivery of items sold to the buyer within seven days of the close of the fair. If there is a delay in delivery past seven days of the last of the fair, written notification of the reason for the delay and delivery arrangements must be given to the fair office. All animals must be removed by 11am Sunday, October 18, 2020.
 13. Consequences for failure to comply with delivery rule will be loss of 50% net sale after 7 days and banned from participating in auctions the following year if not complied with delivery after 14 days.
- TERMS OF SALE: Payment is due at the close of the Auction. Credit may be extended to previous buyers and to those who make arrangements with the Fair Office prior to the Auction. With prior approval, the buyer will be sent a statement which will be due and payable upon receipt. Visa/MastCard/American Express/Discover accepted.
