The purpose of the General Sales Department is to oversee and coordinate the sale of projects shown at the Brazoria County Fair. This includes the Junior Livestock Auction, Commercial Heifer Auction, Ag Mechanics, Market Sale and Student Art Auction.

1. Exhibitor must be present at the auction to sell their items. In the event of a death in the immediate family or illness verified by a doctor, participation in a Texas Education Agency sanctioned activity or scholastic ineligibility, special permission to allow another person to sell for the owner may be granted by the General Sales Superintendent if notified at least one hour prior to sale. The substitute seller must be a family member or a member of the same 4-H Club or FFA with the exception of the Art Auction. The substitute must also meet all requirements as a junior exhibitor in the Brazoria County Fair. These are the only circumstances permissible for excusing the owner's attendance at the auction.
2. A charge for buyer/seller picture will be deducted from net proceeds of each item sold.
3. In order to comply with the state law on the beef check-off, two dollars (\$2) will be deducted from the sales price of each steer and heifer.
4. Any injured, sick or defective animal may be removed from the sales by show officials.
5. A 5% sales fee will be charged by Brazoria County Fair Association.
6. In any Brazoria County Fair Association Sales the Brazoria County Fair Association acts as a commissioned broker only. The Brazoria County Fair Association makes no representations, guarantees, or warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.
7. Exhibitors selling in Auctions are prohibited from making any substitutions of items sold.
8. All sellers in Auction must deliver or make arrangements for delivery of items sold to the buyer within seven days of the close of the Fair. If there is a delay in delivery past seven day of the last day of the Fair, written notification of the reason for the delay and delivery arrangements must be given to the Fair Office. All animals must be removed by 11 am Sunday, October 18, 2020. Poultry and rabbits must be processed before delivery unless buyer specifies otherwise.
9. All participants must comply with the Brazoria County Fair Association General Rules and Regulations printed in this catalog unless otherwise specified.
10. W-9 forms must be completed by each exhibitor in order to pick up sale lot back numbers.
