

Jr. Livestock Awards Program

Sponsored by Phillips 66

Saturday, October 17, 2020 at 11 am, following the livestock judging contest at the Livestock Show Arena the public is invited to view the presentation of the Junior Livestock Special Awards.

1. Only Brazoria County 4-H and FFA Members are eligible for these awards.
2. A High Point Award will be given to the exhibitor who accumulates the most points in the Junior Livestock Show. This award cannot be won two years in succession. In case of repetition, next in line will receive the award.
3. The Second High Point Award will be given to the runner-up exhibitor that accumulates the most points in the Junior Livestock Show. Third through tenth places for High Point Award will receive recognition.
4. Points will be given for one entry in each livestock department. An additional one point per department entered will be given each exhibitor for participation. Point systems will be as follows:

1st Place - 10 Points, 2nd Place - 9 Points, 3rd Place - 8 Points, 4th Place - 7 Points, 5th Place - 6 Points
6th Place - 5 Points, 7th Place - 4 Points, 8th Place - 3 Points, 9th Place - 2 Points, 10th Place - 1 Point

If a tie exists, the exhibitor with the most participation points will be the winner. If there is still a tie, the exhibitor with the most first places will be the winner. It will be necessary for exhibitors to fill out an application form listing all entries shown. This form **MUST BE SIGNED BY THE EXHIBITOR AND HIS/HER PARENTS** and turned in by 8 pm on Thursday, October 16, 2020 to the Livestock Office.

5. Recognition will be given to the Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions of the Market Steer, Market Swine, Market Lamb, Market Goat, Commercial Heifer, Commercial Heifer Pen of Three, Scramble Heifer, Breeding Beef Heifer, Pen of Market Rabbits, Single Market Rabbit, Market Turkey, Market Broiler and Ag Mechanics departments.

6. Junior (ages 8-10), Intermediate (ages 11-13) and Senior (ages 14-19) Showmanship awards will be presented in the Commercial Heifer, Market Swine, Market Lamb, Market Goat, Market Steer and Breeding Beef departments. Only one Showmanship award will be presented in the Scramble Heifer department. Ages will be determined as of September 1, 2020. Winners will be selected on merits received for fitting their own animals during their respective judging events. An exhibitor may receive more than one showmanship award during any one year; however, **no exhibitor may receive the same award two years in succession.**
