

Market Sale

This committee has been formed to service a need of youth exhibitors at the Brazoria County Fair. The committee members' purpose is to act as liaison between potential buyers of market animals and the youth interested in selling non-auction animals. No guarantee of sale is implied by this committee, but rather an intention of assisting in the successful completion of the project involved.

Rules and Regulations

1. The entries in this activity are subject to General Livestock, General Sales, and Fair Rules printed in the current catalog unless otherwise specified.
2. Only market animals exhibited and shown at the current Brazoria County Fair and not selected for the Junior Livestock Auction or Commercial Heifer Auction are eligible.
3. This committee will attempt to sell all animals entered, to be sold on a first come, first serve basis according to available buyers.
4. All prices will be set by the committee prior to Fair time and will be available for review previous to commitment to sell.
5. **“All sales established between the buyer and the exhibitor will be final with no exceptions.”**
6. All prices established by this committee include processing and delivery of market poultry and rabbits, with other animals to be sold “on the hoof” delivered unless otherwise specified by buyer
7. All sellers in Auction must deliver or make arrangements for delivery of items sold to the buyer within seven days of the close of the fair. If there is a delay in delivery past seven days of the last of the fair, written notification of the reason for the delay and delivery arrangements must be given to the fair office. All animals must be removed by 11am Sunday, October 18, 2020.
8. All exhibitors selling in the Market Sales must be present on Sunday, October 18 to load and or deliver their animal and pick up disposition papers from auction. All disposition papers must be signed by the exhibitor and buyer. All signed disposition paperwork must be accompanied by a stamped, fully addressed thank you card(s) to the buyer and to any additional add-ons and returned to the fair office by November 30, 2020 before a check will be released. Any disposition paperwork received after this date may not be paid.
9. Eligible exhibitors must fill out and turn in the completed entry form to the market sales office no later than 12 noon Thursday, October 15, 2020 in order to participate. This form must be signed by parent/guardian before turning in.
10. Friday 5 pm, October 16, 2020 will be the extent of intentions by this committee.
11. Disposition papers must be picked up Saturday, October 17, 2020 8-11 am, in front of Livestock Office.
12. A 5% sales fee will be charged by Brazoria County Fair Association.
13. Consequences for failure to comply with delivery rule will be loss of 50%net sale after 7 days and banned from participating in auctions the following year if not complied with delivery after 14 days.

Terms and Conditions: Market Sale Contracts shall be paid for by buyer at the time the buyer's agreement is completed. If Market Sale Committee is unable to provide buyer with the animal requested, buyer's money will be refunded.
