

# Open Beef Cattle

**Chairmen - Stacy Fitzgerald & Jennifer Garcia**

**Entry Fee:** \$30 per animal, **Jr. Entries Deadline:** September 4, 2020, 5 pm Fair Office

**Ranch & Out of County Only Entries:** 6 am - 8 am the day of show

**Check-Ins:** All drops for Jr. entries must be turned into Livestock office before day of show.

**Arrival Time:** Friday, October 16, 2020, 6 am - 8 am at Show Ring in Livestock area for ranches and out of county entries only.

**Judging Time:** Friday, October 16, 2020, 9:30 am at Show Ring

**Release Time:** Sun., Oct. 18, 2020, 7 am - 11 am, only bulls, out-of county entries, and ranch entries that come in on day of show will be released after judging of the show on Fri., Oct. 16, 2020. No other animals will be released.

## Rules

1. The entries and awards in this department are subject to the General Livestock and Fair rules printed in this catalog, and Texas Animal Health Rules unless otherwise specified.
2. Entries are open to the state.
3. The owner of each breed entry over 8 months of age must submit a copy of that entry's registration papers. For each breed entry under 8 months the owner must submit a herd handler and copies of sire and dam registration papers. All registration papers must accompany the entry form and be turned into the Fair office by entry deadline or animal will be shown in a crossbred class. **Registration papers will be checked with entries. All animals without papers will be shown in crossbred class.**
4. Number of entries per exhibitor will not be limited. Each animal may show in only one class. **No family entries will be accepted.**
5. Breed association rules will be followed for cow/calf pairs. Example: Brangus and Santa Gertrudis breeds state that a calf that is not registerable as a purebred for these breeds cannot be shown as a calf at side.
6. According to the individual breed rules, entries must be submitted as a cow/calf or as 2 separate entries. If the calf is entered as an individual entry then it cannot be shown as a calf at side. If a calf is shown at side of its dam, then it cannot be entered as a separate, individual entry.
7. All Other breeds will include breeds not listed; check Purebred Registration Requirements. Crossbred animals include all unregistered animals and all entries not complying with rule #3.
8. Classes may be split based on the number of animals in a class.
9. All out of county and ranch entries must check in on Friday morning of the show, even if pre-entered to receive back numbers and release forms. **Only bulls, out of county entries and ranch entries that come in on day of show will be released after the judging of the show on Friday, October 16, 2020. No other animals, including Scramble Heifers, will be released.**
10. **There will be no releases later than one hour after the conclusion of the Open Beef Show. Bulls will be released after they show. Bulls must be kept in designated area, location to be determined by Livestock Department.**
11. All exhibitors that show cattle in the open show must meet age requirement of eight (8) years of age or in the third grade except for exhibitors entered in the Pee Wee Showmanship.
12. Pee Wee Showmanship will be held before the Open Beef Show (8:30 a.m.). There will be a \$5 entry fee for Pee Wee Showmanship contestants. Only exhibitors not eligible for any junior show competition due to age, but no exhibitor younger than five (5) years of age will be eligible to compete in the Pee Wee Showmanship contest. Pee Wee Showmen should be able to control their animal with minimal show ring supervision. **Pee Wee Showmen are not allowed to exhibit in the Open Beef Show.** Last year's Pee Wee Showmanship winner will not be allowed to compete in this year's competition. Late entries will be accepted until 8 am the

day of the show.

13. All bulls are required to have a nose ring or nose lead. No bulls will be allowed in Livestock Area until show day, October 16, 2020.

14. All bulls **must** be removed from the fairgrounds at the conclusion of their showing. No bulls will be permitted to stay on the fairgrounds overnight.

**15. NO BULL BORN AFTER FEBRUARY 28, OF CURRENT YEAR WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW.**

**16. All Brazoria County Junior Exhibitors must turn drops into the Livestock office before showday. The check-in on show day is reserved for out-of-county and ranch entries only.**

**17. No animal substitutions will be made after the entry deadline.**

18. Any animal that exhibits signs of being unethically altered or fit will be disqualified. See General Livestock rule 11 on page 101.

**Bull Show Order:**

BULLS will be shown by division.

American, British, Exotic and Crossbred. Champion and Reserve Champion will be named for each division.

Division champions/reserve division champions will return for the selection of the grand and reserve champion bull honors.

**American Division:** Beefmaster, Braford, Brahman, Brangus, Red Brahman, Red Brangus, Santa Gertrudis, Simbrah, Other American Registered Breeds (American papered females)  
American Division Champion and Reserve American Division Champion

**British Division:** Angus, Lowline, Other English Registered Breeds (British papered females) English Division Champion and Reserve English Division Champion

**Exotic Division:** Charolais, Limousin, Simmental, Other Exotic Registered Breeds (Exotic papered females)  
Exotic Division Champion and Reserve Exotic Reserve Division Champion

**Crossbred Division:**

Crossbred Classes, Crossbred Division Champion and Reserve Crossbred Division Champion
