Rules

1. Entries in this auction are subject to Student Art Rules, General Sales Rules, and General Fair Rules printed in the current year catalog.
 2. A) The 20 Art Auction lots will consist of the Best of Class, Reserve Best of Class, and Outstanding from the Art I, Art II, Art III, Art IV, and Portfolio divisions, in addition, 5 Judges Choice pieces from the Art I, Art II, Art III, Art IV, and Portfolio divisions, will be selected.
B) Only current fiscal year (since January 1) original undamaged art work drawn by hand that can be framed will be eligible for auction. This includes, wet media, (oil, acrylics, watercolor, tempera, pen-ink) and dry media (pencil, pastels, charcoal.) Art work cannot have been previously shown in any competition.
 3. All items in the Student Art Auction will be sold by the lot.
 4. Each exhibitor will be eligible to sell only one (1) lot.
 5. The designated piece of art from the winning portfolios will be sold.
 6. A Student Art Auction Release Agreement must be signed and notarized by all 9-12 graders and their parents to be eligible to compete in the Student Art program.
 7. The piece of art chosen by the judges for the auction must be the item that sells in the auction. No substitutions of art will be allowed under any circumstances.
 8. The art chosen for auction will be framed and sold including the frame. The \$100 cost of framing will be deducted from the proceeds of the sale unless the student has a sponsor who is covering the cost.
 9. The art will be displayed throughout the duration of the fair.
 10. Exhibitors must be present and checked in for Art Auction half an hour before the reception.
 11. A 5% sales fee will be charged to each lot and deducted from the sale price by Brazoria County Fair Association.
 12. Exhibitor must pick up artwork on final Sunday between 8am - 11am. Deliver artwork to buyer, get buyer to sign disposition paper and return disposition papers along with a Thank You note addressed and stamped to the Fair Office, before check will be sent to exhibitor for artwork.
 13. Consequences for failure to comply with delivery rule will be loss of 50% net sale after 7 days and banned from participating in auctions the following year if not complied with delivery after 14 days.
- TERMS OF SALE: Payment is due at the close of the Auction. Cash, check and credit cards will be accepted. Credit may be extended to previous buyers and to those who make arrangements with the Fair Office prior to the Auction. If proper credit approval is extended, the buyer will be sent a statement which will be due and payable upon receipt. Art sold in the auction will be released Sunday, October 18, 2020 from 8 am to 11 am.
