



Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo AgRobotics Competition Intent to Compete

The AgRobotics Competition will be held Saturday, October 12th, 2018 at the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo in Bryan, TX. This contest is designed to allow members to demonstrate their robotics, engineering, and problem-solving skills. It is intended for Junior, Intermediate, and Senior teams who are capable of designing, programming, testing, and trouble-shooting a robot with no adult assistance.

Starting Monday, August 26th, 2019 at 2pm teams can submit their INTENT TO COMPETE application online at brazosvalleyfair.com/agrobotics. The application will remain open until Friday, September 20th, 2019 at 5pm.

PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW BEFORE REGISTERING

1. This application process is intended for teams that are fully committed to competing Saturday, October 12th at the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo.
2. Only one representative per team needs to complete this form. The representative can be a team member, leader, coach, parent, or County Extension Agent.
3. A team must consist of 3 to 5 members within the same age division (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior).
4. Completing this form does not constitute automatic acceptance nor is it an official entry in the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo.
5. We will use the online form submission time stamp as the official moment of submission.
6. Following the sign-up period, accepted teams will be notified with instructions on how to officially register all team members for this contest on the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo website.
7. Each team that submits this form will be contacted via email to notify them if they have been accepted or not.
8. Team members and one coach will receive complementary admission to the following weekend. **Additional tickets will be available to order on team registration form at a discounted rate. Day of admission will be full price.**
