SPECIAL RULES

1. All entries and awards in this department will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations.
2. Open to all Texas 4-H and FFA members.
3. Lambs will be shown in a five breed format:
 - a. Southdown
 - b. Fine Wool
 - c. Fine Wool Cross
 - d. Medium Wool
 - e. HairedExhibitors must indicate the division of each entry on weight cards.
4. Lambs will be classified prior to judging. Weight cards must be returned to Show Chairman by 9:00am. Exhibitors will be responsible for weighing their own lambs. Scales will be provided by the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo.
5. The top 3 places from each class will be re-weighed. Any lamb with weight more than five pounds over original weigh-in weight will be disqualified. Lambs will not move to next class. No weight limit.
6. Wethers and ewes will be shown together.
7. **Showmanship:** Showmanship is open to all exhibitors. A \$5 fee, cash only, will be collected upon entry into the show ring. Show order will be Sr. – Int. – Jr. **See General Rule # 3, Section g.**
8. Lambs must be slick shorn a uniform length from knee and hock up at time of arrival. Boots may be left on all lambs. No shearing on grounds. No trim tables allowed on grounds. **ANY LAMB CAUGHT ON TRIM TABLE WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED.**
9. **NO UNETHICAL FITTING. See General Rule # 16(a) on page 15.**
10. **No outside shavings allowed – one bag of shavings per entry will be provided. Additional bedding must be purchased from the Brazos County Expo Complex at \$8/bag. See General Rule # 29. See General Rule # 29.**
11. **Quality Counts:** To be eligible to compete in the Prospect Lamb Show, exhibitors will need Quality Counts verification. The Quality Counts verification number must be recorded on the Show Entry Form when entering the project. Please refer to the website <http://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/> for information on how to become verified.

12. The Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo also reserves the right to change the show schedule, delete classes or add breeds/classes at the discretion of the show officials.
13. **Entry Deadline:** September 25th, 2020. **See General Rule 5 on Page 11 for late entry details.**
14. **Premiums:** Prizes will be given in Ring A. Premiums will be paid in Ring B via vouchers that must be redeemed in voucher office. Premiums, Scholarships, Buckles, and Banners will only be awarded in Ring B. The Breed Champion Scholarship and Buckle will only be awarded if is sixty head entered in the show and five or more head in that Breed in the current year.
