SPECIAL RULES

1. All entries and awards in this department will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations.
2. Open to all Texas 4-H and FFA members.
3. Steers to be shown in breed format. The Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo will appoint classifiers to inspect animals. All steers will be classified by a 3 person committee. Decisions of the classifiers will be final and protests will not be considered. Interference with classifiers will not be tolerated. Steers classed out of their respected breeds will be reclassified into the ABC or AOB.

Following the 2017-2021 Texas Show Steer Breed Classification Guidelines, steers will be classified into the following:

4. Official weigh-in will take place at the time of classification. Please bring weight cards to the classification area in the South Arena. Scales will be provided by Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo. No weight limit. Classes will be divided by weight. Each breed will have a Champion and a Reserve Champion.
5. **Showmanship:** Showmanship is open to all exhibitors. A \$5 fee, cash only, will be collected upon entry into the show ring. Show order will be Sr. – Int. – Jr. **See General Rule #3, Section g.**
6. All Steers will be shown with hair in a natural state without the use of glues, paint, adhesive, etc. Steers with any type of glue, paint, adhesive, etc., in the hair will be disqualified and premiums forfeited.
7. **NO UNETHICAL FITTING. See General Rule # 16(a) on page 15.**
8. No trim chutes allowed on grounds. Clippers and blowers are allowed.
9. No generators allowed on the grounds.
10. No cattle tie-outs.

11. **No outside shavings allowed – one bag of shavings per entry will be provided. Additional bedding must be purchased from the Brazos County Expo Complex at \$8/bag. See General Rule # 29.**
12. **Fans:** Only rear fans or side fans are permitted if mounted on display. No on-ground fans or PORT-A-COOLS allowed.
13. **Quality Counts:** To be eligible to compete in the Junior Prospect Steer Show, exhibitors will need Quality Counts verification. The Quality Counts verification number must be recorded on the Show Entry Form when entering the project. Please refer to the website <http://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/> for information on how to become verified.
14. **Entry Deadline:** September 25th, 2020. **See General Rule 5 on Page 11 for late entry details.**
15. The Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo also reserves the right to change the show schedule, delete classes or add breeds/classes at the discretion of the show officials.
16. **Premiums:** Prizes will be given in Ring A. Premiums will be paid in Ring B via vouchers that must be redeemed in voucher office. Premiums, Scholarships, Buckles, and Banners will only be awarded in Ring B. The Division Champion Scholarship and Buckle will only be awarded if there is sixty head entered in the show and five or more head shown in that Division in the current year.
