Following is a list of possible issues, but not limited to :

- Selection of Judges**
- Conflict of Interest in pageant committee/volunteering participation**
- Conduct of individuals involved in pageant committees/ volunteers**
- Inappropriate action of pageant committee/volunteer with sponsors**

Any and All questions for the Central States Fair / Black Hills Stock Show Rodeo Queen Pageants will be submitted to the Central States Fair / Black Hills Stock Show Rodeo Queen Pageant Supervisor.
