PASSES

General Exhibits:

Exhibitors in Open/Youth Home Arts, Floriculture, Valley Produce, & 4-H General: Processing Fee of \$8.00 will be charged. One (1) pass will be assigned to each exhibitor that pays the \$8.00 fee. For the \$8.00 fee, exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as they wish within the Modern Living Building (Foods, Fabrics, Crafts, Floriculture). Ag Building, you may enter as many as you wish in Valley Produce. Please see Photo and Fine Arts for their fees. No cross over between buildings. The Livestock Department is not included in this program.

SYSTEM OF JUDGING: American (This refers to the judging of all items in a given category being judged against one another.)

PROCESSING FEE:

Professional - \$11.00 for the first exhibit entry, \$3.00 per each additional entry.

Amateur - \$8.00 for the first exhibit entry, \$2.00 per each additional entry. Each exhibitor will receive one (1) admission pass, no matter how many entries are made in this department. (No cross entry in other departments for the \$8.00 fee.)

RELEASING: Monday, September 30th, 9:00am-5:30pm. No exhibits will be mailed.

OPEN FINE ARTS GENERAL RULES

Please also read the General Information, Rules and Regulations of the Fair.

- Exhibitors must be 19 years or older to be eligible to enter in the Open Fine Arts Department.
- ALL ARTS MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED AND ADEQUATELY WIRED FOR HANGING. No Exceptions. (Do not tape wire to the back of art work for hanging purposes.)
- Fine Arts is open to everyone. Entries must be suitable for a family show.
- Amateurs must enter in amateur division, professionals in professional division.

Professional: Those whose work is produced for the purpose of selling, or who have a diploma, certificate, degree, or have three or more years of training, or teach in their media.

Amateur: Does the work for the pleasure involved; receive no money for their work; and has had little or no training.

- **Only original work completed within the last two years and not previously shown at the Central Washington State Fair is eligible.** Work done under instruction, copies of other's photographs or work, overpainting of photographs, a photograph finished to appear as a painting (pigment must be applied directly to canvas over artists' own drawing,) or work from Commercial Kits will not be eligible.
- Private Business Cards, notes, advertising or any other type of commercialism on art work will not be allowed.
- **SALES:** Those desiring to sell their art work must put their price on the entry form. The Fair will charge 20% commission on all sales. The CWSF Office will mail payment for art sold less 20% commission after Fair closes. Sales will be handled by the Superintendent or clerk in the Art Department. No sold items will be released until the close of the Fair.

- Only original work by the exhibitor, finished within the last two years and not previously shown at the central Washington State Fair will be eligible.
- Entries must be suitable for a family show.
