RULES:

- All paintings must be dry, framed or mounted – not TAPE or GLUE mounted – and equipped with hooks or cords for hanging. May have glass frames.
- All drawings and sketches must be mounted on stiff cardboard or mat for hanging. No tape or glue.
- One item per person, per lot number. Work must be original and not copied and made by the exhibitor. No commercial entries. No work that has been entered before in this fair will be accepted.
- **AMATEUR ONLY – An amateur makes less than 30% of their income from their work in the cultural arts area.**
- A Best of Show and Honorable Mention ribbon will be awarded in each class (No Premium).

- The term glazed means fired glazed
