Entry Deadline: Wednesday, August 1

(For poultry from the following counties: Wood, Clark, Marathon, Taylor, Juneau, Adams, Jackson, Portage, Lincoln, LaCrosse, and Monroe. If department entries are not filled by said date, the Fair Board reserves the right to take entries from outside the above counties.)

No exhibitor shall show more than 50 birds with limitations of 2 entries per lot number.

Exhibits to be in Place: Monday, August 20 by 6 p.m.

Judging: Tuesday, August 21 at 9 a.m.

Exhibits Dismissed: Thursday, August 23 after 2p.m.

All poultry must be out of the building by 6:00 p.m.

Do not place any garbage in manure

REMEMBER TO INCLUDE YOUR PREMISE NUMBER ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.

If not a Wisconsin tested flock, bird needs to be banded with identification. Write band identification number on entry form where noted. If bird falls under a state certified flock, write “State Certified Flock” across top of entry form.

Coop Rental: \$1.00 per bird (includes feed, water & care)

The show will be cooped in the classified manner as to variety and sex; the exhibitor is prohibited from substituting birds or changing them from one coop to another.

All awards will be made by comparison and judges will use as their guide the American Standard of Perfection.

Exhibitors and visitors will be prohibited from handling other than their own birds without the consent of the owner.

Competent attendants will have full charge of feeding and caring for stock and, whether exhibitors are present or not, they may rest assured that their stock will be carefully looked after and duly considered for awards.

The department officials are free to remove any birds showing evidence of a contagious disease.

All exhibits are entered at the risk of the owner.

Cock and hen birds are birds hatched before January 1 of the exhibit year. Cockerel and pullet birds are birds hatched on or after January 1 of the exhibit year.

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Male and Female will be awarded in Chickens and in Water Fowl. A Supreme Grand Champion will be awarded over all. (No Premium)
