# CHOWCHILLA SPRING FESTIVAL QUEEN CONTEST

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### Requirements: Parents Please Note!!!

1. The number of contestants will be limited to eight (8). If more than eight applications are filed, the first eight applications received will determine the contestants.
2. Contestants must be between the ages of 16 and 21, have never been married, do not have any children, and must live in the Chowchilla trade area. The Queen must relinquish her title to the 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-Up if any portion of these requirements change other than a change of residence due to attending college.
3. Contestants are only allowed to compete for Chowchilla Spring Festival Queen once.
4. Contestants must have written parental or guardian consent. (She should have a driver's license and/or access to transportation.) Parent or Guardian will be responsible for the cash value of all tickets issued to them – sold and unsold – and all must be turned in no later than 3:30 p.m. the day of the BBQ. All money and tickets must be on premises the day of BBQ.
5. Cash received for tickets sold must be deposited into the Spring Festival account as stated by the Spring Festival Committee. We will go over this with you at the first meeting and provide you with helpful tools to help complete this.
6. All girls must agree to participate in the Coronation Program and any scheduled rehearsals. If a talent portion of the program is included, they must also agree to participate in the talent rehearsals.
7. There is a limit of 12 Poster Pictures per Queen Candidate. Posters cannot be larger than 22" x 28", with pictures being no larger than 8" x 10". Posters or other materials may not be posted (including Facebook) until authorized by the Queen Chairman. Poster Board will be furnished by the Committee.

### Requirements for Coronation:

1. Contestants will wear dresses or attire set as the theme of the evening. This will be decided each year by the group of contestants and/or Chairman.
2. Contestants MUST supply information for the MC in writing at least one week prior to the Coronation.
3. Practices will be scheduled at the most convenient time for the majority. Contestants are expected to make all practices and be on time.

### Queen Requirements:

The contestant crowned as Queen will be expected to attend all events when requested by the Spring Festival Committee. When attending these events the Queen shall always wear her crown, sash and clothing appropriate for the function they are attending.

## **Compensation and Awards:**

The Spring Festival Committee will give each contestant \$80.00 to be used toward her attire for the coronation, posters, etc.

Contestants will only receive monetary awards as long as 400 tickets have been sold.

Contestants will receive 10 cents per ticket sold. However you must sell at least 400 tickets and all money, tickets sold and unsold tickets must balance. All money, tickets sold and unsold must be turned in the day of the BBQ for audit. Checks for this money earned will be mailed to the contestants after the audit of their tickets is completed and balanced.

All tickets (sold and unsold) and money must be turned in at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday of the BBQ.

Awards are as follows:

Queen will receive \$500.00

1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up will receive \$300.00

2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up will receive \$200.00

All other contestants will receive \$100.00 as long as they have sold at least 400 tickets.

This information and much more will be reviewed at the first meeting with the contestants and their Parent or Guardian.
